Last year we raised over £500 and donations of £75 were made to each of these causes. Free food was provided for needy Mums attending Milk & You events at the Dave try Methodist Church. Great Ormond Street Hospital received a donation for the treatment of babies suffering from cancer and The United Nations Refugee Council for children around the world.

Your donations also helped us, to supply baby baths full of goodies and supply £50 one off grants to families in desperate need.

EXAMPLES OF THE DIFFERENT KINDS OF NEEDS EXPERIENCED THIS YEAR

expressed in this prayer request sent out to the prayer groups who support us. It reads "We are in the process of supporting a Mum with 3 children, including 2 five month old twins. She is here on a work visa and currently on maternity leave. Her rent has now been increased and is £27 pounds more than her total income. Very difficult decisions, about feeding her family, possible homelessness and care costs if she eventually returns to work are impacting her mental health.

We also helped two Dads. For one, we paid for his emergency dental health appointment and the other for a travel cot and mattress. You have all created light in darkness with your donations this year.

As we continue to receive these cries for help, it is always important to be alerted to real stories behind them. You have a wide diversity of skills to use more powerfully as a member of the Baby Project and in turn we link with other groups like Milk&You and the Big Issue who have more firsthand experience of the reality of needs and the stories behind them.

In this spirit of responding to need with simple acts of kindness, we have received messages of thanks. e.g.

"I think it fair to say that Mum M, struggling financially, was overwhelmed by her delivery of nappies which will last for ages". This was the reply of a dental receptionist when we sent an emergency payment. She simply said over the phone, "Bless you all"
