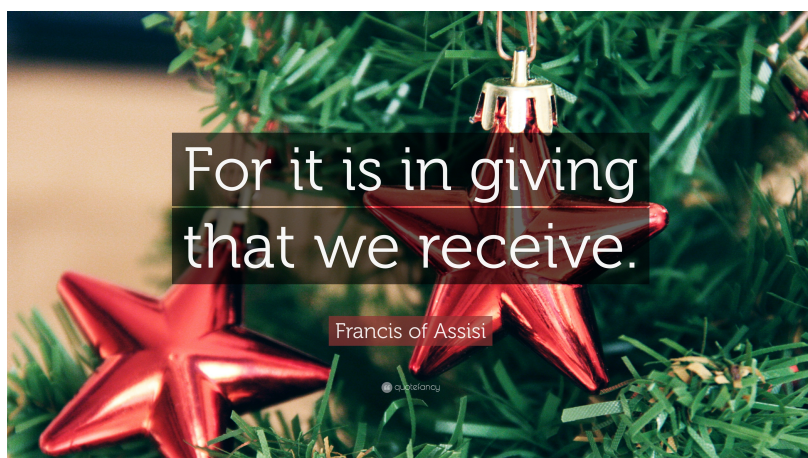

They literally have only; one chair, no furniture, living out of a suitcase. But this is just temporary accommodation. All the friends they made in the hotel when they first arrived last year have all been moved around the country.

They have no money coming in and her husband leaves every morning to walk around trying to find a job. He was a mechanic and a barber in Syria and she was a nursery nurse. His English is not as good as hers so that is why he is struggling. They are living from food bank donations.
