PURPOSE

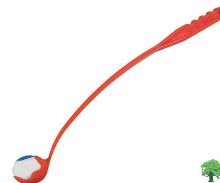
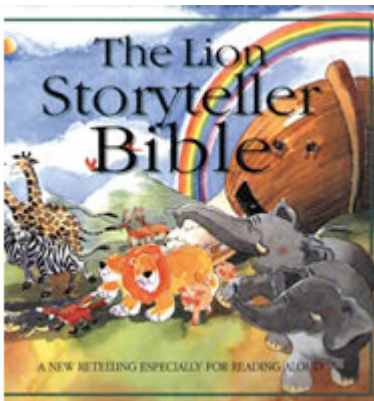
- to explore the importance of "self awareness" in everyday life and through reflection on the story of David and Goliath
